All NPU-L members will be required to provide proof of membership eligibility in order to vote as per NPU-L by-laws membership is defined as:

Any person 18 years of age or older whose primary place of residence or any person who owns property or who is employed by a corporation, institution or agency which owns property or has a place of business or profession within the NPU may be a member. **Each such organization may designate one person and one alternate who is eligible as its voting representative to the NPU. Said organization or institution must send a letter to the NPU designating their voting representative and one alternate (to vote in place of the designated representative, in the event that the representative can't come) by January 31st of each calendar year. The designated representative and alternate may have only one vote. There shall be no cost associated with becoming a member of the NPU. Acceptable forms of membership verification Driver License or State ID, Utility Bill, Lease, or Deed.**

Technology Upgrade to existing permitting and enforcement system.

*The City of Atlanta will conduct information sessions the week of November 16-20, 2009 in the Atrium of City Hall, to introduce Accela Automation, a **web based workflow management system** to streamline business processes across multiple departments.
